MEMORANDUM FOR Military Personnel Officers of all States, Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, the District of Columbia, and Human Capital Management (HCM) Division

SUBJECT: Revision of Warrant Officer Promotion Eligibility Criteria (PPOM # 22-025)

1. Reference. National Guard Regulation (NGR) 600-101 (Warrant Officers Federal Recognition and Related Personnel Actions).
2. Applicability. Applicants for appointment as Warrant Officers in the Army National Guard.
3. Purpose. This revised policy changes the reference above to reflect applicants above the grade of E4 continue to accrue Time-in-Grade (TIG) while in a Warrant Officer Candidate status until appointment as a Warrant Officer.
4. Effectively immediately, reference 1, paragraph 2-10d, is changed to read: Enlisted applicants in the grade of E7 with a minimum of two years TIG on the day before appointment to WO1 may be appointed to WO1 upon completion of WOCS and upon completion of WOBC may be promoted to CW2. The following statement will be placed on the NGB Form 89 for appointment: "Applicant is an E7 with two years TIG on the day prior to appointment as a WO1. The applicant may be promoted to CW2 on the day following successful completion of WOBC." The effective date is no earlier than the day following graduation."
