ANGI 51-504, Air National Guard Legal Assistance Program. This instruction describes Pre-Mobilization Legal Assistance (Pre-MLA) and Post-Mobilization Legal Assistance (Post-MLA), which must be provided by Air National Guard (ANG) base legal offices. Pre-MLA is a matter within the inherent authority of the commander to ensure unit readiness. Post-MLA implements 10 U.S.C. 1044(a)(4) as added by Section 524 of the FY 2001 National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA). This instruction is applicable to ANG units. OPR: NGB-JA. Distr: F.
